**Job Title:** Surveying apprentice

## **Job Purpose:**

To develop the skills and knowledge required to support project management surveying activities and contribute to the delivery of Property Maintenance and Asset Investment programmes. The role will be supported by structured rotational placements across a range of teams to support learning and development.

## **Key Responsibilities**

- To complete the Apprenticeship Training Programme (maximum of 2 years)
- Gain practical experience across a range of work areas in line with the apprenticeship framework.
- Develop project management and surveying skills while supporting the delivery of property maintenance and investment projects.
- Complete all training, college work, and assessments linked to the apprenticeship on time.
- Support the project management surveying team with day to day tasks, with guidance from experienced colleagues.
- Assist in checking contractor information such as measurements, costs, and progress reports.
- Attend team, site, and contractor meetings to support learning and development.
- Carry out work in a timely, organised, and professional way.
- Comply with all health and safety requirements and the Group's Code of Conduct.

The list is typical of the level of duties the post holder is expected to perform or be responsible for. It is not necessarily exhaustive and other duties of a similar type and level may be expected from time to time.
