









Job Title: Bricklaying Apprentice

Job Purpose:

To develop the skills and knowledge to assist in bricklaying in our repairs and maintenance team.

Key Responsibilities

- To learn the full range of bricklaying tasks associated with the repair, maintenance and refurbishment of our properties (under supervision)
- Under supervision, support a bricklayer to carry out all installations, repairs and maintenance work required and all other bricklayer related duties including general bricklaying, brickwork repairs, pointing, paving, concrete work and preservation work
- To ensure risk assessments, method statements, product information and COSHH data sheets are accurately followed
- To comply with the Group's Health and Safety policy

- To carry out all tasks in an efficient and timely manner
- To offer an excellent service to our customers
- To comply with the Group's customer service standards and Code of Conduct
- Develop an awareness of specific access equipment to be used for working at height and use in accordance with method statements

To develop knowledge, skills and behaviour to assist in building surveying activities. This will include working on major repairs, building safety works, sustainability initiatives and planned investment works.

Key Responsibilities

- To gain experience in the full range of professional disciplines within the apprenticeship framework
- To ensure risk assessments, method statements, product information and COSHH data sheets are accurately followed
- Assist the building surveyor with defect diagnostic surveys of properties to identify the cause of such defects and develop specifications, designs, drawings etc. for remedial works using a range of software including Office365 and CAD
- Work in collaboration with our Property Team to deliver a customer focused service
- To comply with the Group's Health and Safety policy


- Carry out Building Surveying administration tasks such as booking appointments with customers, typing up written notes and logging information in Gentoo's corporate system




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

Job Title: Business Administration Apprentice

Job Purpose:

To assist in the delivery of a customer-focused service within all Property teams. To learn to provide administrative support in the co-ordination and delivery of repairs and maintenance services.

Key Responsibilities

Customer Service

- Manage customer enquiries whether in person, by telephone, in writing / online in a courteous and professional manner
- Demonstrate ownership and responsibility of customer issues, working with colleagues or other agencies to resolve customer enquiries
- Adhere to Gentoo Group's policies and procedures

Customer safety is Gentoo's number one priority. The Fire and Building Safety Team play a critical role in ensuring that the fire and structural safety risks in Gentoo's properties are well managed and that customers are involved in how we manage these risks in their homes.

• This role will involve working from the office to support the team in reviewing safety information and out on site, supporting the Fire and Building Safety Team to carry out building safety inspections and fire risk assessments. This role will also include working with customers to engage with them about fire and building safety risks.

Key Responsibilities

- Supporting the Fire and Building Safety Team to carry out fire risk assessments and building safety inspections in Gentoo's buildings
- Assisting the development and review of safety cases in the Group's 25 high-rise residential buildings
- Assisting the Fire and Building Safety Team to plan and manage its work to ensure high standards are maintained
- Analysing data to identify trends and potential issues and discussing these with relevant members of the Fire and Building Safety Team
- Developing good working relationships with colleagues and internal and external partners

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



If it is the first time you have used the system it will ask you to create a new account.


Enter a password and select "Continue" then enter your personal details.


- 4. You will then need to verify your account by sending an email to the address you have provided. Follow the link in the email to do this
